
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2616 by House Committee on Elections

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2616 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2616 would prohibit the Secretary of State and county election officers from disqualifying certain individuals as poll workers on the basis of residency or registered voter status if the person is an active military member, the spouse or other dependent of an active military member or is enrolled on a full-time basis in any public or private postsecondary educational institution located in this state. The bill would also prohibit the disqualification of a poll worker based on a person's age.

The Secretary of State indicates HB 2616 would not have a fiscal effect on the agency's operations. The Kansas Association of Counties indicates HB 2616 would not have a fiscal effect on the counties.
