
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for SB 482 by Senate Committee on Ways and Means

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 482 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 482 would provide that county clerks are not required to send revenue neutral rate notices to owners of property that is exempt from property taxation.

The Department of Revenue indicates that the bill would have no fiscal effect on its operations. The Kansas Association of Counties indicates that the bill has the potential to reduce county government expenditures on the production and distribution of revenue neutral rate notices; however, an exact estimate of this effect cannot be determined.
