
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2263 by House Committee on Health and Human Services

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2263 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

In the pharmacy setting, pharmacists and students/interns are permitted to administer immunizations pursuant to a protocol established with a physician. HB 2263 would expand this authority to include pharmacy technicians. All training, restrictions, and requirements currently in place would apply to pharmacy technicians. Any additional restrictions or limitations could be established by the physician protocol.

The Board of Pharmacy indicates HB 2263 would expand state authority to match current federal authority (which preempts state law), the allowances in the bill have effectively been in place in Kansas for two and a half years. The bill would essentially codify provisions of the Federal Prep Act that have been in place since the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic. As a result, the Board anticipates no fiscal effect on the Board.
