**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2373 by Representative Collins

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2373 is respectfully submitted to your committee.


HB 2373 would create two fireworks seasons from June 27 through July 5 and from December 26 through January 1 of each calendar year.

The State Fire Marshal notes that fireworks sale dates are currently authorized by regulations adopted by the State Fire Marshal and states enactment of the bill would have no fiscal effect on the operations of the agency.

The Kansas Association of Counties indicates enactment of the bill could increase fireworks sales which could result in increased sales tax revenue to local governments.

The League of Kansas Municipalities indicates enactment of the bill would have no fiscal effect on cities.
