
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2831 by House Committee on Taxation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2831 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2831 would require findings of a service-connected disability or death by federal officials to be probative. The bill would prohibit state agencies and municipalities from requesting or demanding a veteran's private health information for the purpose of determining eligibility for service-connected or non-service-connected disability benefits and would prohibit the reconsideration of disability determination made by federal officials as specified in the bill. The bill would also make related definitions and specify allowed documentation for verification of disability or death.

According to the Kansas Commission on Veterans Affairs Office and the Kansas Department for Aging and Disability Services enactment of HB 2831 would not have a fiscal effect for either agency.
