
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for SB 104 by Senate Committee on Financial Institutions and Insurance

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 104 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 104 would permit state and local governments to assess a surcharge when payment is made to the entity via use of a debit or credit card.

The Kansas Department of Education, Kansas Department of Revenue, Kansas Department of Labor, and the Office of the State Bank Commissioner indicate that SB 104 would have no fiscal effect. The Kansas Association of Counties states that SB 104 would allow counties to offset fees charged for credit and debit card processing.
