
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 336 by Senate Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 336 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 336, as introduced, would remove the annual requirement for operators of storage tanks to demonstrate completion of required training. This change would allow the Storage Tanks Program within the Kansas Department of Health and Environment to modify the renewal calendar through regulations. The fees for this program are currently set in regulations.

The Kansas Department of Health and Environment indicates that SB 336 as introduced would not have a fiscal effect on agency operations. The agency reports that they do not anticipate changing fee levels in the near or long-term future.
