SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2330 by House Committee on Health and Human Services

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2330 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2330 would amend the Radiological Technologists Practices Act. The bill would change annual licensing dates from July 5 to October 1. The bill would require certification from the American Registry of Radiological Technologists to use specific titles, abbreviations, or designated letters when a technologist verifies his or her credentials.

The Kansas Board of Healing Arts indicates enactment of HB 2330 would have no fiscal effect.
