SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 258 by Senate Committee on Judiciary

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 258 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 258 would remove the following forms and legal documents from the statutes:

1. Motion for Judicial Review of Documentation or Instrument Purporting to Create a Lien or Claim
2. Affidavits related to a variety of topics such as age, income, etc.
3. Judicial Finding of Fact and Conclusions of Law Regarding the Documentation or Instrument purporting to Create a Lien of Claim
4. Appendix of Forms Relinquishment of Minor Child to Agency
5. Judgment Form
6. Issuance and Content Forms
7. Notice of Extension to File Contractor Lien
8. Notice of Extension to File Lien
9. Notice of Intent to Perform
10. Release of Intent to Perform
11. Petition Pursuant to Chapter 61 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated
12. Summons (Small Claims Procedure)
13. Return on Service Summons
14. Defendant's Claim


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Those forms would be included in a document published by the Judicial Council.
