The Kansas Board of Emergency Medical Services would like to support the passage of HB 2752.

The Kansas Board of Emergency Medical Services is introducing Legislation this session (SB 546) that would create a data collection system to collect pre-hospital data similar to what is collected by the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) within the Trauma Registry. The legislation, supported by the Board, is very similar to this Legislation and will also allow us the opportunity for improvement of quality pre-hospital care to Kansas citizens in addition to the Traffic Records System operated by the Kansas Department of Transportation's (KDOT).
