## Hearing on HB 2619-Relating to the licensure of adult care homes.

Chairman Bethell asked Katherine McBride to explain HB 2619.

Joe Ewert, Commissioner of Survey and Certification for the Kansas Department on Aging, spoke in favor of <u>HB 2619</u>. He stated that they were in favor of a Grandfather Clause for approximately ten small Intermediate Care Facilities for the Mentally Retarded currently licensed or certified in Kansas which have less than six beds. (<u>Attachment 1</u>) He and Bill Rein, KDOA Chief Counsel, stood for questions. Rep. Gonzalez, Rep. LeDoux, Rep. Kelly, and Norm Furse asked questions and made comments. Chairman Bethell asked for clarification as to why they wanted the Grandfather Clause. Norm Furse asked for clarification to some of the bill's contents. Rep.
