1	AN ACT concerning property; relating to ownership of pore space.
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3	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
4	Section 1. (a) As used in this act, "pore space" means a
5	cavity or void, whether natural or artificially created, in a subsurface
6	sedimentary stratum.
7	(b) Title to pore space in all strata underlying the surface of
8	lands and waters is vested in the owner of the mineral rights or interest. A
9	conveyance of title to the mineral rights or interest conveys the pore
10	space in all strata underlying the surface of the real property. Title to pore
11	space may not be severed from title to the mineral rights or interest. Any
12	instrument or arrangement that seeks to sever title to pore space from title
13	to the mineral rights or interest is void. Leasing pore space is not a
14	severance prohibited by this act.
15	(c) This act does not affect transactions before the effective
16	date of this act that severed pore space from title to the surface estate.
17	Sec. 2. The provisions of this act are declared to be severable and if
18	any provision word phrase or clause of the act or the application thereof

any provision, word, phrase or clause of the act or the application thereof
to any person shall be held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the
validity of the remaining portions of this act.

21 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 22 publication in the statute book.

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
