AN ACT concerning the Kansas highway patrol; allowing the Superintendent to charge and collect fees for certain services.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

5 Section 1. (a) The superintendent of the Kansas highway patrol is 6 hereby authorized to fix, negotiate and enter into contracts, and charge 7 and collect fees for providing security and traffic patrol services at events 8 held by private entities where the superintendent determines the number of 9 people attending such event will have a significant impact on traffic and law enforcement activities on state highways. Such fees shall be fixed 10 11 negotiated in order to recover all or part of the expenses incurred in 12 providing such services by the Kansas highway patrol. The Kansas 13 highway patrol shall determine the amount of traffic patrol services and security necessary at events held by private entities and shall set 14 fees accordingly. This section shall not apply to any event organized or 15 operated by the state of Kansas or a city, county or other political 16 subdivision thereof. All moneys received by the superintendent for such 17 18 services shall be deposited in the state treasury in accordance with the-19 provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto, and shall be-20 eredited to the Kansas highway patrol operations fund.

(b) The Kansas highway patrol shall only fix negotiate, charge
and collect fees pursuant to this section when, in the opinion of the
superintendent, the expenses incurred to the highway patrol for
providing such security and traffic patrol services will exceed \$20,000.

25 (c) There is hereby created the highway patrol private security 26 fund. All moneys deposited into the highway patrol private security 27 fund shall be used only for the purpose of providing for security to 28 private entities pursuant to this section. All expenditures from the 29 highway patrol private security fund shall be made in accordance with 30 appropriation acts upon warrants of the director of accounts and 31 reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the superintendent 32 or the designee of the superintendent. All moneys received by the 33 superintendent for such services shall be deposited in the state 34 treasury in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and

amendments thereto, and shall be credited to the highway patrol private security fund.
