## AN ACT repealing K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 25-4501; concerning a presidential preference primary; amending K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 25-4501 and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
Section 1. K.S.A. 2014-Supp. 25-4501 is hereby amended to read as. follows: 25-4501. (a) Subjeet to the provisions of this seetion, there shall be held a presidential preferenee primary eleetion in the year 2016 2020, and every fourth year thereafter.
(b) On or before November 1, 2015 2019, and on or beforeNovember 1 every fourth year thereafter, the seeretary of state shall certify to the governor, to the chief clerk of the house of representatives and to the secretary of the senate a commen date in the next succeeding year onwhich at least five other states will hold a presidential preference primary election, a delegate or mass convention or a catteus of qualified voters at which delegates to a national convention are-selected. On or before each steh date, if the secretary of state determines that there is no common date on which at least five states are conducting streh a selection process in thenext suceeeding year, the secretary of state shall certify to the governor, the ehief elerk of the house of representatives and the seeretary of thesenate on a date, which shall be on or before the first Tuesday in April of the next following year, on whieh the presidential preferenee primary election shall be held.
(c) The date certified by the secretary of state purstant to subsection (b) shall be the date on which the presidential preference primary election atthorized by subsection (a) shall be held in the state of Kansas.

See. 2. Section 1. K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 25-4501 is hereby repealed.
Sec. 3 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
