- Second procurement of KanCare launched 1/1/2019
 - 360 readiness documents reviewed by State of Kansas
 - 137,307 members, up 6%. Includes 6,648 new members from Amerigroup
- State Rapid Response Calls through January
 - 27 Total MCO issues logged
 - One issue specific to UHC relating to duplicate Authenticare authorizations
 - Issue resolved in system as of 1/31/19
 - Providers held harmless
- New design on provider relations and issue management
 - So far, going well
 - Remaining vigilant on core operational issues while adding new benefits and services

What are Value Added Benefits?

- Value Added Benefits are additional benefits that UnitedHealthcare offers our members beyond the KanCare covered benefits.
