SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2064 by House Committee on Judiciary

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2064 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2064 would specify that when a law enforcement officer believes there is sufficient evidence for a person to be charged with a violation of law, the person shall be taken into custody and taken without unnecessary delay before a judge of the district court.

The Office of Judicial Administration indicates enactment of HB 2064 would have a negligible fiscal effect on the Judicial Branch.
