Testimony issues before Appropriations Committee January 27th, 2021

The number of veterans that will need services for long term care is expected to increase in the coming years. There is a shortage of veteran homes to meet the current need. In northeast Kansas there are no Kansas Veterans Homes, yet the highest number of vets resides in this area.

Vets needs to be recognized for the selfless service that have provided to our country by meeting their long term health needs as they were promised when they enlisted in the military.

Caregivers need to be provided with the information and social work help if needed when an admission is made to the veteran's home. Often the system is hard to navigate and clear information is needed.
