Having been a Licensed Kansas Barber for 63 years, it is my feeling that there are some issues that need to be updated.

1. It is necessary to implement a Chair Lease License. This will help the Barber Board keep track of barbers who do not own their own shop.
2. Senior Licenses should be offered to barbers over 70, at a one time fee. Licenses are important to older barbers, although it will be a non working license.
3. The procedure needs to change, moving from a 3 year expiration to a 2 year expiration. The license will be less costly and more likely to be renewed on time.
