Subject: Bill Brief on SB 204

Senate Bill 204 prohibits a court from requiring psychiatric or psychological examinations of an alleged victim of any crime.

Section 1 enacts new law to provide that in any prosecution for a crime, a court shall not require or order a victim of the crime to submit to or undergo either a psychiatric or psychological examination. This new section will be part of the Kansas criminal code.
