AN ACT concerning crimes, punishment and criminal procedure; relating 1 2 to unlawfully tampering with electronic monitoring equipment; 3 modifying criminal penalties; amending K.S.A. 2020 Supp. 21-6322 4 and repealing the existing section. 5 6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:* 7 K.S.A. 2020 Supp. 21-6322 is hereby amended to read as Section 1. 8 follows: 21-6322. (a) Unlawfully tampering with electronic monitoring equipment is, knowingly and without authorization, removing, disabling, 9 10 altering. tampering with, damaging or destroying any electronic 11 monitoring equipment used pursuant to court ordered supervision or as a 12 condition of post-release supervision or parole. 13 Unlawfully tampering with electronic monitoring equipment is a: (b) 14 Severity level- $\frac{6}{8}$ , nonperson felony in the case of electronic (1)monitoring equipment used pursuant to court-ordered supervision or as a 15 16 condition of postrelease supervision or parole for any felony; and (2) class A nonperson misdemeanor in the case of electronic 17 monitoring equipment used pursuant to court-ordered supervision or as a 18 19 condition of postrelease supervision or parole for any misdemeanor or 20 used pursuant to court-ordered supervision in any civil case. 21 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2020 Supp. 21-6322 is hereby repealed.

22 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 23 publication in the statute book.
