**MEMORANDUM**

Subject: Bill Brief – HB 2132

HB 2132 designates a bridge on U.S. Highway 77 as the PFC Loren H Larson Memorial Bridge.

HB 2132 provides that Bridge No. 0081-B0058, which is on U.S. Highway 77 in Riley County, will be designated as the PFC Loren H Larson memorial bridge. Highway signs designating the bridge as the PFC Loren H Larson memorial bridge will not be placed until the requirements of K.S.A. 68-10,114 are met. K.S.A. 68-10,114 provides that the secretary of transportation should not place any signs designating memorial highways or bridges until receiving sufficient funds from gifts and donations to cover the costs of those signs. Additionally, the secretary must receive an additional 50% of the initial cost to pay for future maintenance or replacement costs for the signs.
