**MEMORANDUM**

Subject: Bill Brief – SB 95

SB 95 exempts motor vehicle odometer reading recording requirements when such recording requirements are exempted by federal law.

Under current law in K.S.A. 8-135, on a reassignment of title the odometer reading is recorded on the certificate of title. There are certain vehicles exempt under current law from that odometer recording requirement, including vehicles that are 10 model years or older and trucks with a gross vehicle weight of more than 16,000 pounds.

SB 95 would instead exempt any vehicles from odometer recording requirements on certificate of titles if those vehicles are exempt from the recording requirements under federal law.

If enacted, the provisions of SB 95 become effective January 1, 2022.
