SB389:

As written, I am not for this bill for the reasons listed below:

Realizing that the utilization of election machines is a county level decision, it is my opinion that machines should only be present for voters with a documented disability from a licensed provider.

Regarding line 18 and the use of pollbooks: In the random precinct audits, the CVR AND the signature signed onto a paper print out from pollbooks should also be included in the ballot audit. Recounting illegally-cast ballots hardly counts as a valid audit. This bill needs to include how to prevent the software engineers writing the software for the machines from pulling in "inactive voters" from Pollbooks into the CVR. There also needs to be language that makes the security of the machines be verified by a county elected official and not just the manufacturer of the machines.

While participating in canvassing efforts in Finney County, voter rolls consistently contain many registered voters at an address that is a college dormitory. Many of those "residents" listed at that address have moved but continue to be listed as a registered voter. These "voters" could be utilized by software programmers to add votes to CVR and skew results. Please address statutes to this security issue.
