Subject: House Bill No. 2165

Summary

House Bill No. 2165 allows all vehicles that are more than 35 year of age to qualify as an antique vehicle for registration purposes. The bill also removes street rod vehicles as a class of vehicles.

Section 1 – modifies the definition of "antique" for the purposes of antique vehicle registration. Current law provides that antique means any vehicle more than 35 years old propelled by a motor using petroleum fuel, steam or electricity, or any combination thereof. HB 2165 would modify that defined term, so that the definition of antique would apply to those vehicles more than 35 years old regardless of the age or type of components or equipment installed on the vehicle.

<u>Section 2-4</u> – removes the classification and reference to "street rod vehicles." The class of "street rod vehicles" would no longer exist.
