Senate Federal and State Affairs
Committee Rules

1. The Chair reserves the right to limit testimony that is cumulative in nature and may limit testimony, when necessary, to a specific number of minutes.
2. Any bills introduced must have an RS number and copies provided to the committee assistant prior to the meeting.
3. The Committee meets 10:30 a.m. to noon, unless extended by the Chair.
4. Committee members shall not address conferees until and unless permission is granted by the chair.
5. The chair reserves the right to limit questioning of conferees by committee members in the interest of time and in the interest of fairness to conferees and other committee members.
6. No conferee shall be interrupted during presentation of their testimony, except with the permission of the chair.
7. Cellular phones shall either be turned off or set to be silent the Committee Room.
8. Video, audio taping, *photographically* is prohibited unless approved in advance by the chair.
9. There shall be no recording, audibly, photographically, or otherwise, of committee members' voting.
10. A request from any member that his/her vote be recorded shall be granted.
11. Granting excused absences is reserved to the Chair.
12. Adjournment is reserved to the Chair.
13. For any dispute or uncertainty, the Chairman's ruling will be final.
14. All powers, duties, and responsibilities not addressed herein are reserved to the Chair.
