The Committee on **Judiciary** recommends **SB 286** be amended by substituting with a new bill to be designated as "House Substitute for Substitute for SENATE BILL NO. 286," as follows:

"AN ACT concerning the governmental response to the COVID-19 pandemic in Kansas; extending the expanded use of telemedicine and expiring such provisions; extending the suspension of certain requirements related to medical care facilities and expiring such provisions; modifying the COVID-19 response and reopening for business liability protection act; extending immunity from civil liability for certain healthcare providers, certain persons conducting business in this state and covered facilities for COVID-19 claims until January 20, 2023; amending K.S.A. 2021 Supp. 48-963, 48-964, 60-5503, 60-5504, 60-5508 and 65-468 and repealing the existing sections.";

And the substitute bill be passed.
