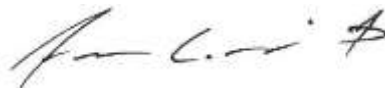
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2305 by Representative Curtis, et al.

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2305 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2305 would allow cities, counties and local governments to pay compensation or wages at a rate higher than the minimum wage.

The Department of Revenue indicates that the bill would have fiscal effect, but it is unable to estimate what the fiscal effect would be because it does not have enough information to make a reliable projection. The League of Kansas Municipalities indicates the bill would have a fiscal effect on cities, but the fiscal effect is unknown.
