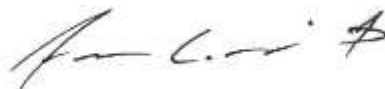
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2335 by House Committee on Agriculture

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2335 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2335 would establish the Kansas Cotton Commission and the enacted bill would be cited as the Kansas Cotton Commission Act. The bill would establish the duties and responsibilities of the Commission, including requirements for membership and attendance at meetings. The bill would also levy an assessment upon cotton marketed through commercial channels in Kansas and establish the procedures for management of the assessment. The bill would establish penalties for violations of the Act and the procedures for dissolution of the Commission.

According to the Kansas Department of Agriculture, enactment of HB 2335 would have no fiscal effect on the agency.
