



















What is a regulatory sandbox?



Two Paths Forward

• <u>Industry-Targeted Sandbox</u>: Highlights a particular industry to allow for the temporary waiver of rules and regulation.

• <u>All-Inclusive Sandbox</u>: Allows for any industry to take advantage and apply for the temporary waiver of rules and regulations.
