Thank you for allowing USA Kansas and KSSA to provide oral testimony on HB 2040. As written, we stand as a proponent to this bill.

We believe this bill encourages our public schools to take great notice that preschool is an important part of the child's educational journey. By providing funding to this population will allow districts to either fund start up programs or fund the current programs in place. Districts with rapid growth would need these resources within the year to help meet the requirements for a program that would be of high caliber.
