MEMORANDUM

Re: H.B. 2476; Requiring legislative approval of any national heritage area or national historic trail in the state of Kansas and prohibiting state funding of any national heritage area or national historic trail unless such funding is first approved by the legislature of the state of Kansas.

Section 1, subsection (a) (pg. 2, line 2) would state that designation by the United States national park service of any national heritage area¹ or national historic trail² that extends beyond federal land within the state of Kansas shall require the approval of the legislature of the state of Kansas.

Under subsection (b), state funds shall not be expended or transferred from state agencies to match federal moneys for national heritage areas, national historic trails or any similar or successor designated areas without the approval of the legislature of the state of Kansas.

Under subsection (c), state lands, water, property or facilities shall not be included in any designated national heritage area, national historic trail or any similar or successor designated areas without the approval of the legislature of the state of Kansas.

H.B. 2476 would become effective upon publication in the statute book.
