Chairman Carpenter and members of the committee, thank you for this opportunity to share our **SUPPORT** on HB 2808. My name is Andy Sanchez and I have served previously on the Topeka Metropolitan Transit Authority Board (TMTA), now the Topeka Metro, the Long Range Transportation Advisory Committee and a Joint Legislative Transportation Vision Task Force. The increase of violence in the transit industry extends to verbal abuse, physical assault and numerous other criminal acts. Steps need to be taken to properly employ deterrents to these random acts of violence and it is incumbent upon us to see that this does not continue.

The Kansas AFL-CIO works hard to improve the quality of life for Kansas' workers. We know, as lawmakers you have those same objectives. To ensure that we continue to employ the highest quality of workers to transport our family, friends and loved ones safely, we must hold our expectation of passengers / ridership to a higher standard.
