I would like to thank the Health and Human Services committee for the opportunity to testify on behalf of HB2622.

I work at a Kansas casino as a EVS Deep Cleaner.

Every casino employee has the basic human right to breathe clean, smoke-free air. It shouldn't feel necessary to fight for the right to clean air. Because it can lead to lung conditions, heart problems, and even lung cancer, secondhand smoking is extremely deadly. I have observed and heard firsthand the effects that secondhand smoke has had on my non-smokingteammates and customers.

The smoke-filled air has caused friends and coworkers of mine to develop allergies and respiratory problems. Secondhand smoke has also caused respiratory problems for me, including episodes of coughing and phlegm buildup.

Additionally, there has been one incident that could have caused property damage. A patron disposed of their cigarette before putting out their ashes and cigarette, causing a small fire to develop up inside before my coworkers and I scrambled to put it out.

Our clients may be impacted by secondhand smoke as well. Non Smokingpatrons and their families may experience discomfort and health risks as aresult of secondhand smoke entering other areas of the casino, like the restaurant.

Communities with smoke-free laws report a reduction in hospitalheart attack admissions of up to 17%, according to the CDC.

Systems for ventilation, air conditioning, and heating have their limitations and cannot completely remove secondhand smoke.

Since 85% of Kansasresidents do not smoke, a smoking ban in casinos would not affect earnings.

While many other casinos have outlawed smoking, their earnings have notchanged. The smoking ban in Kansas casinos will only improve and enhancethe working and visitor environments.

Please consider yourself in our shoes. We all work to provide for our families and meet our responsibilities, and we shouldn't be forced to work incircumstances that would make it difficult for us to do so. The clean air willbe greatly appreciated by both casino employees and guests. Making the impact that we all greatly need is up to you and us.

Please join us in making a good difference for future generations.
