I am a proponent on Sb 352.

It was devastating to watch and hear all the stories of our most vulnerable, our elderly held like prisoners with no visitations to show love or support in these metrical facilities. They had no advocacy person allowed into these rooms, the families were denied to hold a hand as their loved one lie dyeing alone.

In 2021 we begged you to come back into special session. You did and we will always be gratful that you gave us the Religious Exemption against the government overreach. But you said you would do more – It has been 3 years.

We can never let this happen in Kansas ever again. Please pass sb 352, concerning health and healthcare; enacting the John D. Springer patient's bill of rights; requiring hospitals to allow in-person visitation in certain circumstances; requiring hospitals to adopt visitation policies and procedures; creating a civil cause of action for violation of such rights.
