Written Testimony Before the Senate Financial Institutions and Insurance Committee

Thank you for the opportunity to provide written testimony on behalf of the Kansas Association of Property and Casualty Insurance Companies (KAPCIC), our state trade association for domestic property and casualty insurance companies. Most of the KAPCIC member companies are domiciled Kansas companies and our members live and work here in the state.

KAPCIC supports SB 25 and the reduction of the tax on surplus lines companies from 6% to 4%. Surplus lines insurance is very important to the insurance market in the State of Kansas. Surplus line insurers underwrite unusual or difficult-to-insure risks, to prevent that risk from undermining each state's ability to regulate its insurance market. Reducing the tax on surplus lines companies will reduce the cost for many insured consumers in the state.
