Subject: House Bill No. 2108

Summary

House Bill No. 2108 would provide a sales tax exemption for sales of certain school supplies, computers and clothing during an annual sales tax holiday. The sales tax holiday would begin at 12:01 a.m. on the first Thursday in August and end at midnight on the Sunday following. The following items would be exempt from tax:

- (A) Clothing or clothing accessories or equipment with a sales price of \$300 or less per item;
- (B) school supplies, school instructional materials or school art supplies with a sales price of \$100 or less per item;
 - (C) prewritten computer software with a sales price of \$300 or less per item; and
 - (D) computers or school computer supplies with a sales price of \$2,000 or less per item.

Sellers would not be required to obtain an exemption certificate for sales made during the sales tax holiday.
