Passage of SB 248 will erode our local sales tax collections and force a shift of the tax Kearny burden onto property taxes. It is estimated that SB 248 could reduce revenues to local Kiowa governmental units by \$180 million or more each year. Twenty-nine of our member Lane counties have some form of a sales taxes and the lost sales tax could mean a reduction of Logan

\$8.6 million annually for the counties share.
