Re: SB 399 - AN ACT concerning motor vehicles; relating to vehicle dealers and

salvage vehicle dealers; requiring that monthly reports be filed on the 25th day of the month; amending K.S.A. 8-2408 and repealing the

existing section.

Good Morning, Chairman Francis and members of the Committee. My name is Don McNeely and I serve as the President and CEO of the Kansas Automobile Dealers Association (KADA). I submit written testimony in support of SB 399, which would change the monthly reporting of vehicle sales by motor vehicle dealers and salvage dealers to the Kansas Department of Revenue, Division of Vehicles from the 20<sup>th</sup> of each month to 25th when the monthly sales tax report is due.

KADA views this proposal as non-controversial and it only makes sense to synchronize the date for the submission of the monthly sales report and the monthly sales tax report associated with vehicle sales by licensed dealers.

On behalf of the Kansas Automobile Dealers Association, I thank you for the opportunity to provide some comments in support of SB 399.
