**Question:** The House Committee on Welfare Reform asked if there were any unobligated moneys remaining in the federal American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) fund, which was provided by the US Treasury for discretionary purposes. The question concerns funding for a matching grant for homelessness.

**Answer:** There are no unobligated moneys remaining in the federal ARPA fund. Prior to the 2024 Legislative Session, an estimated total of \$79.7 million remained unobligated. Proposed adjustments by the Governor and the House Committee on Appropriations have allocated this remaining balance.
