Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

New Section 1. (a) On July 1, 2023, and each July 1 thereafter through July 1, 2028, no transfers to the state water plan fund pursuant to K.S.A. 79-4804 and 82a-953a, and amendments thereto, shall be made if the full amount of sales tax revenue authorized for distribution by K.S.A. 79-3620 and 79-3710, and amendments thereto, is transferred to the state water plan fund.

(b) (1) The state water plan fund shall continue to be appropriated and expended for the purposes prescribed in K.S.A. 82a-951, and amendments thereto, except that:

- (A) On July 1, 2023, and each July 1 thereafter through July 1, 2028, or as soon thereafter on such dates as moneys are available:
- (i) \$5,000,000 shall be transferred from the state water plan fund to the water technical assistance fund established in section 2, and amendments thereto; and
- (ii) \$15,000,000 shall be transferred from the state water plan fund to the water projects grant fund established in section 3, and amendments thereto; and

- (B) for the fiscal years ending June 30, 2024, June 30, 2025, and June 30, 2026, an amount not less than \$15,000,000 from the state water plan fund shall be applied toward the retirement of any water supply storage debt for Milford and Perry Lake reservoirs until such debt is retired.
- (2) The appropriation acts required by paragraph (1) shall only be made if the full amount of sales tax revenue authorized for distribution by K.S.A. 79-3620 and 79-3710, and amendments thereto, is transferred to the state water plan fund.
