Chair Tyson and Members of the Senate Committee on Assessment and Taxation:

The Kansas Food and Farm Coalition strongly supports the passage of SB 377, and the provision to immediately eliminate the state-level sales tax on food and food ingredients. Our organizations are united in support of the immediate elimination of the state sales tax on food, which will:

Save Kansas families money. This is urgently needed as food costs continue to rise due to inflation and families struggle to put food on the table.

Keep money in Kansas communities and in farmers' pockets. With money saved by not paying the high state sales tax, consumers can spend more on food from their local grocery store or farmers market.
