Subject:	SB 387—Continued Enrollment for Nonresident Students in the Open Enrollment Law

Senate Bill 387 would amend the school district open enrollment law to authorize nonresident students currently attending in a school district of nonresidence to remain enrolled at such school district.

SB 387 would clarify that any nonresident student who was enrolled in a school district of nonresidence during the 2023-2024 school year shall be permitted to continue such enrollment in such school district until the student graduates from high school. Similarly, any nonresident student accepted for enrollment at a school district of nonresidence on or after June 1, 2024, shall also be permitted to continue such enrollment until such student graduates from high school.

SB 387 would take effect on July 1, 2024, upon publication in the statute book.
