## Testimony in Support of House Bill 2613 Presented to the Senate Committee on Education

March 15, 2024

Senator Baumgardner and Members of the Committee,

D.A.R.E. America is grateful for the opportunity to provide additional written testimony in support of HB 2613. The Youth Services Division of the Kansas Attorney General's Office is sponsoring this important bill. The Drug Enforcement Administration calls fentanyl *"the single deadliest drug threat our nation has ever encountered."* Since 2015, Kansas has experienced a 561% increase in fentanyl deaths. What are we doing to protect our children from this threat?

Multiple states have begun to introduce and enact new laws requiring fentanyl prevention education to be presented in all schools, in some cases, annually to students in all grades. In response to the Fentanyl crisis, D.A.R.E. America has launched the following in-class lessons and assembly presentations.
