For this past election, November 7, 2023, my husband and I received unasked for applications for advanced voting. Most concerning is that our names, address, AND BIRTHDATES were already filled out. We do not share that information with anyone, especially in a pre-packaged bundle, perfect for a bad actor to steal our identity. I shred my bills with my name and address!

I was campaigning for candidates running in my local election and heard from several Johnson County residents that they not only received filled out ballot applications for themselves, but for residents who used to live at their address from more than a year ago.

This unnecessary action put many Johnson County resident's personal information at risk and opened the door for rampant election fraud. It should not be allowed to happen again.

We strongly support Kansas Senate Bill 366, particularly the following language:

(2) The application for an advance voting ballot included in such mailing shall be the official application for advance ballot by mail provided by the secretary of state. No portion of such application shall be completed prior to mailing such application to the registered voter.
