Re: HB 2446- Written Opposition Testimony

Thank you Chairman Thompson for allowing the City of Topeka to submit written opposition testimony to HB 2446 which would preempt from adopting or enforcing an ordinance that restricts, taxes, imposes a charge or fee upon, prohibits or otherwise regulates the use, disposition or sale of plastic straws or containers.

The City of Topeka currently has no ongoing discussions regarding this topic. If the legislature passed this bill, it would have no immediate impact. That is the very reason this legislation is not needed. This is a local issue that is best handled at the local level. The public has lots of opinions on this topic.
