Subject: SB 505 - Increasing the KPERS retirement benefit multiplier for members who are security officers of the department of corrections.

Senate Bill No. 505 increases the KPERS retirement benefit multiplier for security officers in the KPERS correctional subgroup from 1.75% (KPERS 1 service prior to January 1, 2014) or 1.85% (KPERS 1 service after January 1, 2014 and all KPERS 2 service) to 2% for all years of participating service of such security officers.
