Subject: Bill Brief on HB 2010

House Bill 2010, As Amended by House Committee, updates statutory cross-references to provide proper jury instruction in cases when a defendant lacks the required mental state to commit a crime.

Section 2 amends K.S.A. 22-3428, which is the statute related to persons found not guilty because of a mental disease or defect. Current law references K.S.A. 22-3220 to provide that mental disease or defect is a defense to prosecution. This statute was repealed and replaced by K.S.A. 21-5209, so this bill strikes the old cross-reference and replaces it with the new statute.

The amendments adopted by the House Committee on Judiciary added updates to the same cross-reference in K.S.A. 12-736 (Section 1) and K.S.A. 22-3428a (Section 3).
