
Re: Providing immunity from prosecution for certain drug crimes when persons seek or provide medical assistance related to the use of a controlled substance HB 2487


Dear Members of the Kansas Legislature,

It's addition to the drug supply is taking more American lives than ever before. Life preservation should be your number one concern and this bill has the ability to do just that.
