SB510 Proponent Written Only Testimony

Chairwoman McGinn and members of the committee,

The proposed change to this bill seems to strike a balance between individual property rights and public health considerations. Subsection (d) ensures property owners have a reasonable expectation of access to essential city services, specifically sewer systems, without facing undue financial burdens. The exemption of cases due to non-payment strikes a balance between individual responsibility and the public interest.

I see no reason this bill shouldn't pass and I encourage the committee to pass SB510 out of committee favorably.
