Please vote YES on SB352 Patients Bill of Rights.

During the COVID scare many hospitals would not allow spouses or other loved ones to visit the patient. When loved ones were allowed to visit, they sometimes complained about the protocols/treatments used. When a spouse demanded custody of the patient so they could be transferred and be provided a different protocol, hospitals refused to release the patient - even when ordered by a judge. Many patients died when held against their will and were treated with treatments they disagreed with.

It is of utmost necessity for patients to have the right to determine their own treatment - even when such treatment is not "approved" by published protocols. The U.N. World Health Organization, WHO, could seek authority to determine health protocols used in the U.S.
